

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

And

STATE UNIVERSITY OF GORONTALO

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made between Our Lady of Fatima University hereinafter referred as "OLFU" and STATE UNIVERSITY OF GORONTALO hereinafter referred to as UNG

WHEREAS OLFU and UNG wish to promote academic exchanges and develop academic collaborations to be of mutual benefit to their students, faculty and staff, and institutions.

WHEREAS OLFU and UNG agree to establish terms and conditions to apply to this Memorandum of Understanding.


NOW THEREFORE both parties propose the academic exchanges to enhance their collaborative projects/activities as follows;

1. Exchange of students/internships
2. Exchange of faculty/staff
3. Joint research projects/activities
4. Joint academic symposium/conference
5. Short course training program


Both OLFU and UNG understand that any subsequent financial involvement shall have to be discussed on each activity basis. Details of specific cooperative programs shall be set forth in separate annexes which shall be respectively attached in accordance with each specific project/activity. In addition, an appropriate person of each party shall be appointed/designated to coordinate in the development and implementation of specific activities based on this MOU.

This MOU will be effective upon approval by both Universities and shall be valid for a period of five years. It shall be automatically extended for another five years unless there is prior notification in writing not to extend by either party. It may be terminated by mutual consent upon a written notice six months prior to the specified termination date.
