



Memorandum of Understanding for Student Exchange Between
Gorontalo State University and National University Corporation Ehime University

For the purpose of insuring smooth student exchange according to Item 1-2 of the Agreement for Academic Exchange, Gorontalo State University, Republic of Indonesia and National University Corporation Ehime University, Japan agree to the following terms:

- 1. Student Status**
Exchange students in this program will have the status of 'special auditor' at Ehime University and 'special auditor' at Gorontalo State University.
- 2. Number of Students**
Each university may accept no more than three students a year.
- 3. Length of Stay**
The length of stay shall be less than one year. However, if both universities agree, it is possible to extend the stay for one more year.
- 4. Tuition and other fees**
Exchange students are not required to pay examination fees, entrance fees and tuition fees at the host university.
- 5. Transfer of Credits**
Each university will approve the transfer of appropriate credits in accordance with its own regulations.
- 6. Housing**
Each university will endeavor, to the best of its ability, to assist students with securing suitable housing. Payment of rent, if required, and other housing-related fees will be the responsibility of the student.
- 7. Effective Term of this Memorandum**
This memorandum comes into effect on the date both parties sign and shall be valid for five years. In the event that both parties agree, it may be amended and renewed. The agreement can be terminated within the five-year term if both parties agree.
- 8. Note**
Questions or concerns regarding the terms set forth in this Memorandum shall be resolved through consultation as the need arises.
This Memorandum is prepared in Japanese and English and both texts shall be regarded as official. Two signed copies in each language will be prepared and both parties will keep one of each.
