TRIANGLE OF EXTERNAL FACTORS TO OPTIMIZE THE EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

ABSTRACT

This study was conducted to determine the external factors to optimize the early childhood education. This research uses a qualitative analysis based on the model of Hubberman and Milles. Based on the study found that early childhood development will develop optimal if the parents or educators care about what children needs.

Based on the needs of children there are the factors that influence early childhood education: 1) love, 2) nutrition, and 3) stimulation. These major factors will work in synergy and supporting each other and can not be separated. How ever if only the nutrition and stimulation are performed without love, the children will grow and develop into a human being less concerned with others.

I.BACKGROUND
